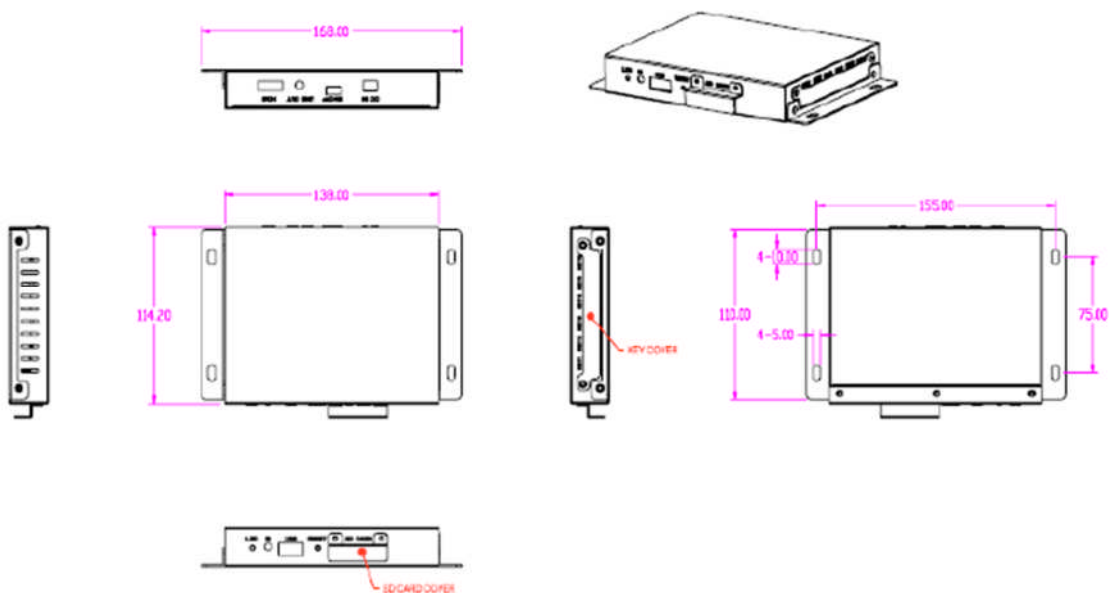

## Remote Control

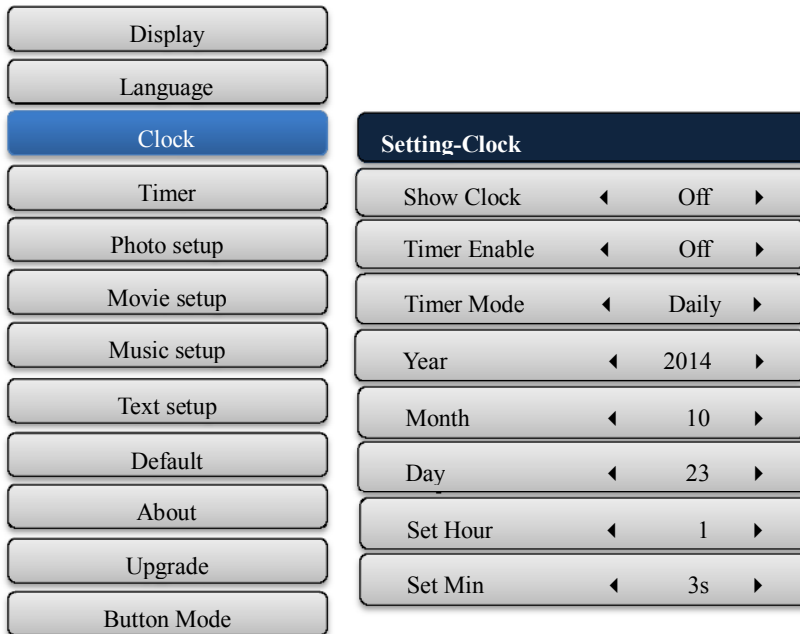

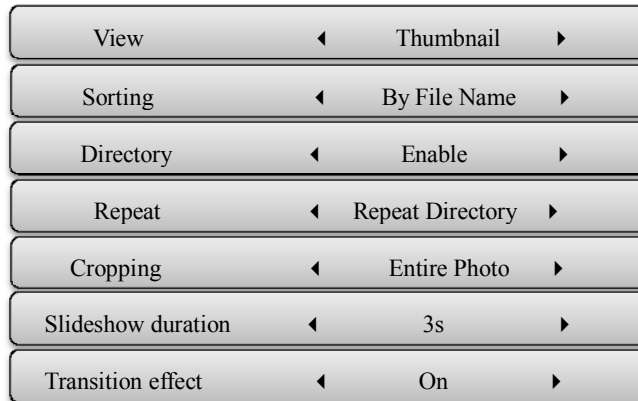

# Advanced Control

## Photo Setup



### 1. View

Thumbnail	A small description
List	A number of items or names listed consecutively

### 2. Sorting

By File Date	Files arrange by the Date
By File Name	Files arrange by the Name

### 3. Directory

Users can select enable or disable directory.

### 4. Repeat

Repeat All	Play the photos from the beginning once or a number of times
Repeat Directory	Directory repeat
Repeat Off	Stop playing the photos once it finished

### 5. Cropping

Entire Photo	Cut out the whole photo
Smart Crop	Smart Crop
Stretch Photo	Cut out the photo to a longer or wider one

### 6. Slideshow Duration

The time interval between slides can be set as 3 seconds, 5 seconds, 10, seconds 30 seconds, 60 seconds and 5 minutes.

## 7. Transition Effect

On	Lighting, sound or scenery effect may occur between slides
Off	No effect will occur between slides

## 5. Subtitle

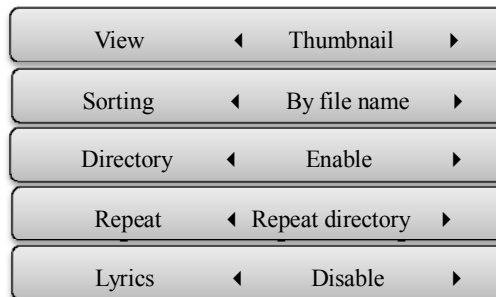
## 6. Resume Play

Off	Not to continue playing the movie again after a pause
On	Continue to play the movie again after a pause or interruption.

## 7. Digital audio Output

Spdif PCM	Covert the current audio format to PCM format and then output
Spdif RAW	Audio format on the disc without treatment, the authentic output from the coaxial and fiber

## Text Setup



### 1. Sorting

### 2. Directory

Users can select enable or disable directory.

### 3. Front Color

There are 4 front colors for users to choose – Black, white, blue and green.

### 4. Background Color

There are 3 background colors for users to choose – Effect 1, Effect 2 and Effect 3.

### 5. Auto Browser Speed

3 auto browser speed can be chosen according to your need – Normal, slow and fast.

### 6. Resume Play

3 types of resume play speed can be chosen – Normal, slow and fast.

# Button Mode

1. Press *SETUP* in the Remote Control, choosing Button Mode to select the suitable mode for you.



2. In Button Mode, you can select either *Audio Display* or *Number Mode* according to your need.



Key 1: Previous Video

Key 2: Next Video

Key 3: Play/ Pause

Key 4: Stop

Key 5: Volume +

Key 6: Volume -

- b. In Number Mode, You have 2 blinking modes to choose – Retail or Museum.



Selected Retail as the blink mode, the buttons will keep blinking every 3 seconds.



Selected Museum as the blink mode, it will only blink when you press the button.

- You can press the button for watching different video.  
For example: Button 1 for watching Video 1.
- If you do not press any button, it will start looping at Video 0.
